

Dear Eighth Grade Parents/Guardians:

The Flight of the Eagle Ceremony

The Flight of the Eagle Ceremony is a celebration of our 8th-grade students and their accomplishments. The ceremony will be held at Stewart Middle School Lovejoy Gym on Friday, May 17, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. This event is a **ceremony** and not a graduation. Each student will receive two tickets for guests to attend. All students are asked to wear a combination of black and white dressy casual attire. Students



should not wear jeans, sweats, or tennis shoes. If you have any questions about the attire, please let us know prior to the day of the ceremony.

In order for your child to purchase any package all lunch, textbooks, athletic, and library charges must be cleared and the consent form below must be signed and returned. Packages will go on sale now until April 30, 2024. You may purchase a package via cash or online https://sms.dcssga.org/. Packages will NOT be sold after this date. A receipt will be given to each student with each payment.
